
#### The role

The Omega Plastics Group is recruiting a new role for our business – a **Business ERP Systems and Data Analyst.** We are looking for someone with the right skills, experience and enthusiasm to become the expert on and optimise our business systems and processes to achieve peak performance across the Group through standardising data capture, cleansing, and developing SOP's and reporting procedures to ensure data is timely and accurate at all times. This is a fantastic opportunity for someone to contribute to the growth of a dynamic business.

Reporting to our Group Finance Director, this role will work closely with all function heads across the Group to understand initially how we work then review our business systems and reporting structures to fully support that in the most efficient and effective manner, ensuring that any changes are documented, trained out to all users, and embedded within the Group.

The role comes with a salary of **between £35,000 and £42,500** (depending on qualifications, skills and experience), 25 days annual leave (plus statutory holidays), Company Pension Scheme, Death in Service, Employee Assistance Program, Cycle to Work scheme and other benefits. It is a permanent, full-time role based at our site on Team Valley but with some working from our Signal Plastics site in Washington.

All candidates must be currently eligible to live and work in the UK.







## Main duties include:

- Understand how we work as a group, how this is reflected in our business process map and our systems, and how each business function uses the systems.
- Become the business systems "super user". Currently the business ERP is Sage 200.
- Identify appropriate changes to streamline the use of the systems and how they interact.
- Develop SOPs for all processes in place and any proposed changes.
- Educate and train users to ensure data accuracy and consistent use of systems.
- Take ownership of the business systems data and develop system KPIs to ensure the data is clean at all times.
- Develop user dashboards either through Sage 200 or Power Bi. To be bespoke for each user to ensure the user data live and accurate data at all times. Roll out reporting through Power Bi where appropriate.
- Understand what is currently used as a report which is off line. Identify what spreadsheets are currently used which can be replicated, controlled, and published through the system. Implement agreed changes using change management principles.
- Review with the operational teams the current BOMs and cycle times held within the systems and update/change where appropriate, using change management principles.
- Pro-actively contribute to the continuous improvement of technology/business processes through identifying opportunities for improvement and implementing changes.
- Support the commercial team to evolve the business pricing models.
- Work with operations and engineering teams to evolve and develop capacity planning models across both tooling and moulding.
- Develop excellent working relationships with all departments within the business.
- Carry out any other duties not listed above as may reasonably be expected of the role

- Experience working with an ERP system within a manufacturing environment (essential)
- An advanced Excel user (essential)
- Experience of using Sage 200, ERP, and Power Bi (desirable)

- Effective problem-solving skills
- Able to present data and insights in a clear and concise way
